



## ART ON THE MOVE: STUDENT/ALUMNI SIGN-UP

You may have heard about Art on the Move from your fellow students, SVS alumni or faculty. Briefly, the SVS Outreach Program, Art on the Move provides real-life experiences for SVS students and alumni, providing hands-on professional career building opportunities by taking them across the state to share their art with others or by returning them to their Missouri hometowns or home regions playing an instrumental part in recruiting the next generation of SVS students. Aligning with the student area of specialty, venues are chosen such as an exhibition in a library or gallery or a film screening at a historical theatre. With the multitude of media areas for student specialization at SVS, students have equally as many ways in which to present their work to the community. In addition to exhibitions, you could present your work as a lecture, workshop, or symposium.

These interactions with communities will be transformative for you and will provide you with the opportunity to develop professional skills, broaden your professional network that will help launch your career, develop resume or portfolio material, and through engagement with the public, expand the cultural relevancy of “contemporary arts” throughout Missouri. AOM supports students in gaining the self-knowledge, experience, skills, and confidence needed to develop unique, creatively satisfying career paths.

We are developing a schedule now for 2018-19. Students are required to have a faculty mentor work with them on the AOM project.
